## Scruton pub walks

---

***Made paths – time varies but this walk is especially suitable for those who must use wheelchairs or scooters***

From the Coore Arms head north along Station Road and around Stubbs Corner.

At Alban Coore place turn right onto Common Lane and then left into The Parklands.

At the "public footpath" sign after 3 The Parklands, turn right and follow the path to the stile where you have a lovely view across the park and of the cedars (more than 300 years old).

Retrace your steps back to the end of The Parklands. Turn left onto Common Lane.

Take the village green road to St Radegund's church where you have an opportunity to visit the church.

When you are ready to leave the church, retrace your steps back to the end of the village green road.

Turn left onto Common Lane and follow the road to the end of the village, through the gate and on the gravel track to Common Stell where you have lovely views through the gate across the farm land.

Retrace your steps back into the village. Opposite the village green take the path at Sycamore House, marked with a "public footpath" sign into Beech Close.

Skirt around the green in Beech Close and take the path (in the diagonally opposite corner) back to Station Road.

At Station Road turn left and return to the start point at the Coore Arms.
