

### ***Maxi – about 1 ¾ hour***

From the Coore Arms head south on Station Road, past the village hall and bus shelter.

Immediately after the water pumping station is a field and, at the southern edge of this field turn left into the field at the “public footpath” sign.

Follow the path, which skirts all around the edge of the field as it comes along the back of the bungalows in Peacock’s Close.

Keep to the hedge until you come to a gap in the hedge (after 4 bungalows) at a stile. Turn right through this gap and take the path, over another stile, to Common Lane.

When you reach Common Lane turn right and follow the road, through the gate, as it turns into a gravel track down to Common Stell.

Cross Common Stell and pass through the gate following the track on towards the River Swale.

After taking in the views across the countryside, retrace your steps along the track, back through the gate and over Common Stell.

Follow the track back through the gate and onto Common Lane.

Continue along Common Lane until you come to the village green where you now have an opportunity to visit the green and St Radegund’s church and yard.

When you have finished visiting the church, cross the village green towards Glebe Cottage. Pass through the kissing gate and take the path back to Blenkiron’s field.

Cross the stile into the field and turn right, following the path along the edge of the field and crossing another stile into Beech Close.

Continue along the road in a straight line and take the path to the south of the green in Beech Close back to Station Road.

When you come to Station Road cross the road and take the path that enters Ward’s field at Stubbs Corner (marked with a “public footpath” sign)

Walk across the field towards the stile you can see to the left of a short section of wall at the far side of the field.

Cross the stile and continue in the same direction along the back of the houses and step down onto Ham Hall Lane at the gap in the hedge.

At Ham Hall Lane turn right and, when you come to Fleetham Lane turn left towards Kirkby Fleetham. Enter the field on your right at the first gate, marked with a "public footpath" sign.

Head west, through the gate and follow the path through the field, past Lucky Barn and over Scruton Stell and on in pretty much a straight line until you come to Low Street.

Turn right and continue along Low Street until its junction with Fence Dyke Lane.

Turn right onto Fence Dyke Lane and continue along this road until it joins Fleetham Lane.

At Fleetham Lane turn left and continue along Fleetham Lane until you come to a stile on your right marked with a "public footpath" sign.

Cross the stile into the field. In the distance you will see the back of the houses in The Parklands, head for the left most of the houses you can see and, when you get closer to The Parklands you will see a stile.

Cross this stile and, when the path comes to The Parklands turn left. At the end of The Parklands turn left. Take the path at Sycamore House, marked with a "public footpath" sign into Beech Close.

Walk diagonally across the green in Beech Close and take the path back to Station Road.

At Station Road turn left and return to the start point at the Coore Arms.
