

### ***Spring house farm shop – about 50 minutes***

This walk is entirely on roads, but the A684 is a fast, noisy, busy road. However it has wide verges, particularly on the south side of the road. It also has lovely open farmland views. Please take especial care if you have children or animals with you as the loud traffic noises can startle them.

From the Coore Arms head south on Station Road, until you come to the junction with the A684 (Cross Lanes Junction).

Cross the A684 and turn right (west) and continue along this road until you come to Spring House farm shop, where you might be persuaded to buy a treat.

[OPTIONAL DETOUR: If you are interested in planes and keen for a slightly longer walk, the road to the left goes down towards RAF Leeming and provides a reasonable location for plane spotting.]

When you leave Spring House Farm Shop come back to the A684 and cross it to Ham Hall Lane.

Walking along Ham Hall Lane will bring you back to Scruton.

### **Return 1 – via Fleetham Lane**

Walk the full length of Ham Hall Lane and, at the end, it joins Fleetham Lane. Turn right along this lane and follow it back to The Coore Arms.

### **Return 2 – across the fields**

Walk along Ham Hall Lane until you come to a public footpath sign on the right hand side.

Turn onto this path which heads towards a mature tree in the direction of Scruton Cricket Club house.

When you come to a field corner, continue a few paces more and the footpath turns left over a stile.

Cross the stile and follow the footpath diagonally across the field to another stile, in the direction of Stubbs Corner.

Cross this next stile and follow the footpath diagonally across the field to the field gate at Stubbs Corner.

Exit onto Station Road and turn right, following the road back to The Coore Arms.

### ***Remember...***

Keeps dogs on leads, leave gates as you find them, take rubbish home and have fun.
