

Latest Siege on Scruton!

You may be aware that there has been another 'call for sites' and this time it's land to be designated for 'employment', that is, industrial and commercial estates. The area submitted by landowners comprises the huge wedge bounded by the railway line, the new bypass road and the residential properties on Low Street, Leeming Bar. Some of this land falls within our boundaries.

The Parish Council takes a pragmatic view that we are unfortunately sited so close to a major intersection that it is inevitable we will be affected by the encroachment of industrial estates, but we consider the current proposal disproportionate. We also take the view that employment is necessary and we are glad that businesses are coming to our local area, but we are fearful of the impact of increased commercial traffic during construction and operation of commercial and industrial activities and, presumably, residential development at some stage. We will be expressing these views in the strongest terms within the consultation period and we urge all householders to add their concerns to our protest.
